

RESOLUTION 2020-3

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE ADOPTING THE JEFFERSON COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Lewisville is located in Jefferson County, Idaho and as a part of Jefferson County is affected by safety hazards within that area as well as within the City of Lewisville, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lewisville and Jefferson County have experienced natural and manmade hazards that result in public safety hazards, damage to private and public property, and harm to the environment; and

WHEREAS, The hazard mitigation planning process set forth by the State of Idaho and the Federal Emergency Management Agency offers the opportunity to consider natural and manmade hazards and risks, and to identify mitigation actions to reduce future risk; and

WHEREAS, A Jefferson County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Mitigation Planning Committee and adopted by the Jefferson County Commissioners on the 19th day of October, 2020 as Resolution No. 2020-1; and

WHEREAS, FEMA Region X has approved the Jefferson County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan with the purpose of reducing the loss of life and property due to natural and manmade disaster; and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan includes a prioritized list of mitigation actions including activities which, when implemented, will help minimize and reduce safety threats and damage to private and public property,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that,

1. The City of Lewisville City Council hereby adopts the Jefferson County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan and directs its implementation through the Mitigation Planning Committee;
2. The City Council shall appoint a representative to serve on the Mitigation Planning Committee led by the Jefferson County Director of Emergency Management; and
3. The City Council requests all city departments to develop actions, directives, Standard Operating Procedures, checklists or other supplemental guidance to ensure its maximum effectiveness.


